





### **Thousand Oaks, California**

Thousand Oaks is a city in Ventura County, California, located about 15 miles from Los Angeles. It is named after the many oak trees that dominate the landscape of rolling hills. Deginated open-space nature areas occupy 34% of the city. Chumash people were the first to inhabit the area over 10,000 years ago. The Chumash had several summer encampments, one which was located at the present day Civic Arts Center site. A relatively new town, Thousand Oaks was incorporated in 1964. The population in 2020 was 126,966 and demographics were 63% white, 1.3% Black, 0.2% Native American and 10% Asian.

The Civic Arts Plaza represents the center of the downtown area. It houses the 1,800-seat Fred Kavli Theatre and the Ray Scherr Forum Theatre. According to the Thousand Oaks Downtown Master Plan, the current design is physically and visually detached from adjacent uses such as the Lakes shopping center and from Thousand Oaks Boulevard. The Master Plan's goal is to make the Civic Arts Plaza both better connected to its surroundings as well as expand its potential as an outdoor destination.

Thousand Oaks Boulevard and adjacent sidewalks and intersections







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### **Constraints**



#### Area 1

- 1 Loading area F needs truck access via **Dalles Road**
- (2) Current main entrance is narrow and hidden

#### Area 2

- (3) Light well not well used
- (4) City Hall stairwell (K) is small and narrow
- (5) Outdoor event area does not work well because of a tree blocking the view
- (6) Building extension to the northeast limits connection between Area 2 and 3
- 7 Tree canopies need protection

### Area 3

- (8) Tree canopies need protection
- (9) Access from parking lot not clear

10 Need to maintain pedestrian safety






City of Thousand Oaks ArcGIS Hub Zoning Map, December 21, 2023


### **Protected Trees (Ventura County Tree Protection Ordinance**)

- Oak: 9.50" single-trunk or 6.25" multiple-trunk girth
- Sycamore: 9.5" girth
- Heritage (any species): 90" singletrunk or 72" multiple-trunk girth
- Historical\* (any species): All
- Tree protection zone: minimum 5 feet outside the dripline or 15 feet from the trunk, whichever is greater




Average hourly temperature in Thousand Oaks





### **Case Study 1: Marin County Civic Center**





**Location:** San Rafael, California **Designers:** Frank Lloyd Wright

**Year Completed:** 1962

Size: 160 acres

#### **Context:**

- Within the City of San Rafael in Marin County, east of Highway 101 and west of San Francisco Bay
- Built into the side of the surrounding hills dominated by oak woodlands
- Gallinas Creek runs along the northern end of the campus

#### **Features:**

- Long horizontal Administration and Hall of Justice buildings link the tops of three hills.
- The buildings connect at the central hill at a 120 degree angle where they join a 80-foot rotunda with a 172 foot gold spire.
- The barrel-arched roof is a blue that is meant to match the sky.
- Additional buildings on the campus include the Post Office, Veterans' Memorial Auditorium and Jail.
- A lagoon and lagoon park are also present on the campus.




### City Hall Second-Floor Plan

**Location:** Newport Beach, California

#### **Context:**

- Formerly an undeveloped site with degraded wetlands, the Civic Center and Park are located in a suburban residential-commercial area of Newport Beach.
- The site is east of the Pacific Coast Highway and adjacent to MacArthur Boulevard to the east.
- San Miguel Drive bisects the northern portion of the park. The site is located just to the north of the Pacific Ocean.

#### **Features:**

- A 100,000 square foot City Hall alongside a public green, anchored by a 17,000 square foot public library.
- A parking structure is on the adjacent side of the green.
   An extensive park with native vegetation interspersed with rotating sculptures stretches northeast of City Hall.
- Beyond a wetland area is a pedestrian bridge spanning a nine-lane road, a lookout tower and a dog park.
- Unique landscape zones in the ecological area include the Desert Garden, Torrey Pine Grove, Coastal Sage Scrub Gardens, wetlands, meadows, and others.





- Location: East Cut neighborhood in downtown San Francisco
- Designers: Pelli Clarke Pelli Architects;
   Adamson Associates International, Inc.; PWP Landscape Architecture; WSP; Thornton Tomasetti
- Year Completed: 2018
- **Size:** 5.4 acre park a living roof above the four-block-long San Francisco Salesforce Transit Center.

#### **Context:**

- Situated in downtown San Francisco, south of Market Street.
- Serves 1,100,000 people within a half-mile.
- Located between Second and Beale Streets, Natoma and Mission Streets.
- Just four blocks from the San Francisco Bay Trail.

#### **Features:**

- A bus and high-speed rail station with a rooftop community park.
- Includes 13 different botanical gardens representing Bay Area ecosystems.
- 800-person amphitheatre, children's playground, public plaza, restaurant, and passive recreation areas.
- 15 entry points including a privately-operated gondola and bridges to surrounding buildings.
- The "Bus Fountain" on the north side of the park is an interactive public art installation that responds to movement of buses below.




